It will be a large-scale event with a variety of activities on offer, targeted at people living and travelling across the region.

The **Green Fair** will be the major community event of the festival, free for all to attend and held on **Saturday April 4, 2020** in the centre of Port Augusta. This will offer a **Sustainability Market**, Green Power Expo, kids entertainment, interactive science, music, dance, art exhibitions, delicious food and more! We expect 2000+ people to attend.

The Sustainability Market will be a key attraction at the Green Fair. It will enable you to connect with the people of the upper Spencer Gulf region, promote and sell your offerings.

A regional and coordinated three-month marketing campaign is planned to run across print, radio, TV, online and via social media platforms to attract people to the festival.

- Stallholders to bring and set up all own shade, tables, equipment and requirements
- Cost: \$30 (excl. GST)
FREE for current Business Port Augusta members
- Powered sites are not available
- Small food vendors must comply with all Health Department Regulations
- An 'Environmental Statement/ Promotional Items/ Giveaways/ Packaging Policy' applies
- Proof of public liability insurance of up to \$10 million (\$20 million if you are a food vendor) is required prior to February 29, 2020.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS AND DEADLINES

1. Go to www.greenpowerfestival.com.au and download the forms applicable to you.
2. Complete the Application Form, Terms and Conditions Declaration and any other requested attachments and send them to us at: info@greenpowerfestival.com.au
3. Applications **open December 2, 2019** and **close January 31, 2020**.
4. Applications will be processed and approvals granted within 2 weeks of receipt.
5. Once approved you will be sent an email and invoice for payment.
6. Once payment is received you will be sent final confirmation of registration.
7. You will be required to forward your valid public liability insurance 'certificate of currency' to us before February 29, 2020.
8. All other information will be forwarded via the email address you provide.

NOTE- The earlier you apply and receive confirmation the sooner you'll be able to make your arrangements.
